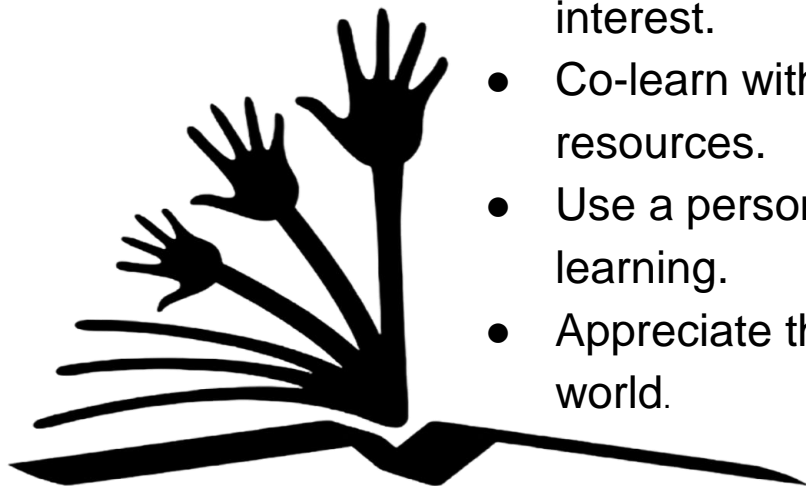

Prehistory: Federated OER Search

"Federated open learning resources" refers to the practice of using federated search tools to find and access **Open Educational Resources (OER)**.

Eg. **OASIS**, search multiple OER repositories at once to broaden your search for materials that are freely available and openly licensed.

"OER Metafinder launches a real-time, simultaneous search across 22 different sources of open educational materials as you hit the Search button."

Issues with Federated Search

Advantages

- Limited to a few trusted sources, hence, no spam
- Did not require duplication of search metadata listings
- Always up to date

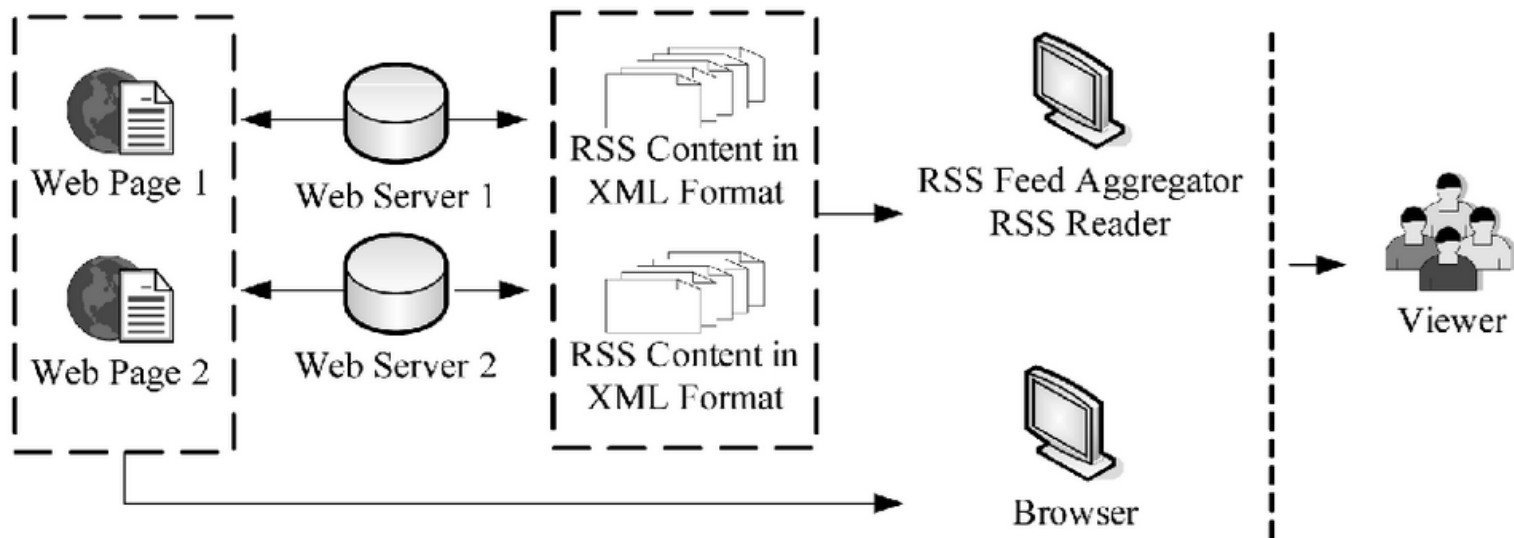
Disadvantages

- Created additional overhead on individual servers
- Unordered results
- No possibility of 3rd party metadata
- Was never better than Google

Issues with Centralization

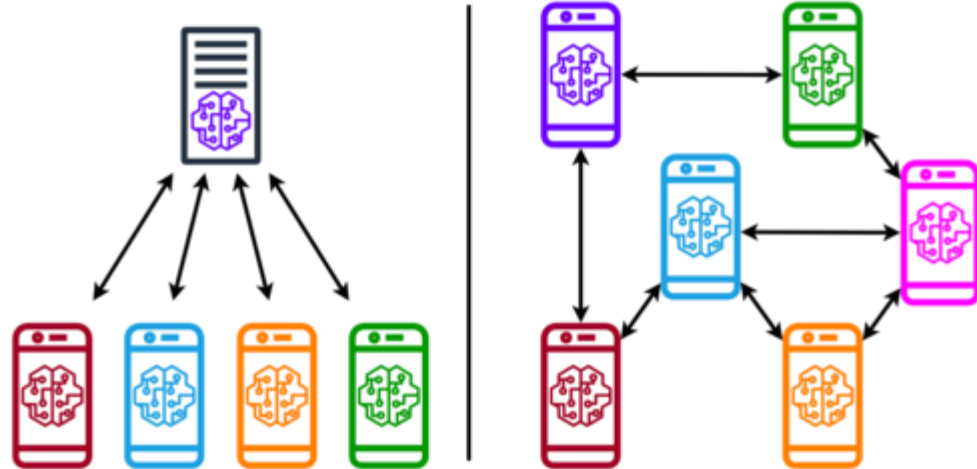
- The Algorithm over relationships

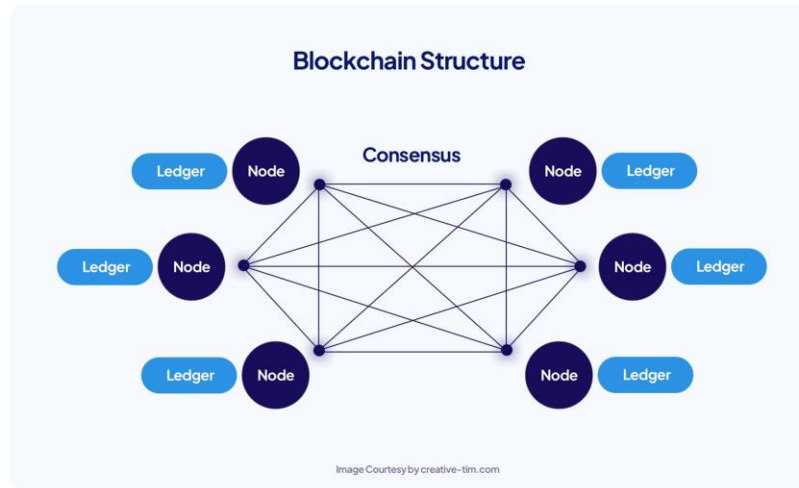


Digression: Blockchain and Consensus Networks

Common types of consensus mechanisms used in blockchain networks include:

1. Proof of Work
2. Proof of Stake
3. Delegated Proof of Stake
4. Proof of Authority
5. Proof of History
6. Proof of Weight
7. Proof of Capacity
8. Proof of Burn
9. Proof of Elapsed Time
10. Proof of Importance

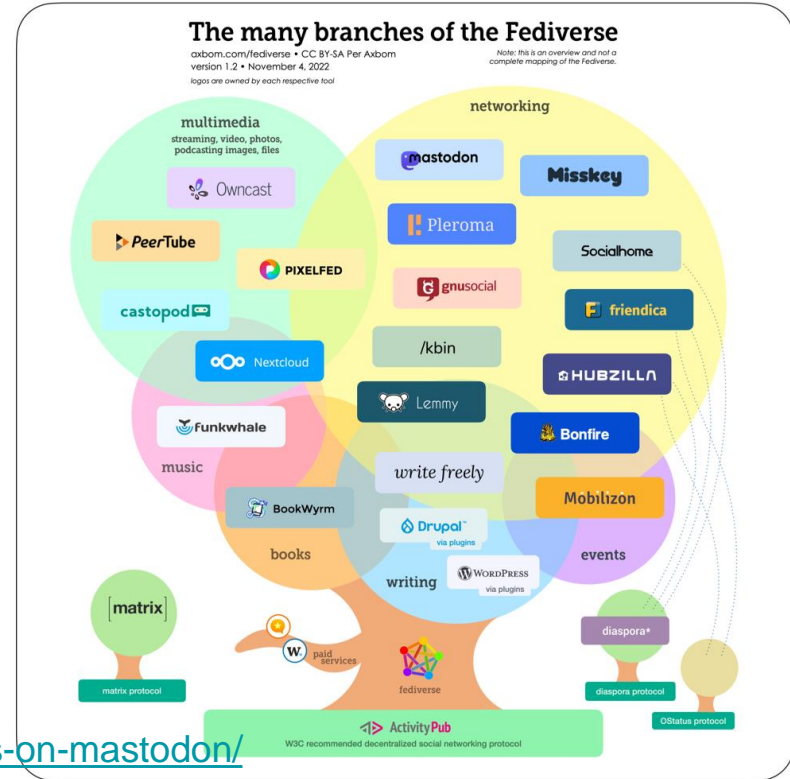
How to Create a Decentralized Community

1. Join a fediverse site like Mastodon
2. Search for a subject or hashtag (or create your own)
3. Follow people who show up

alternatively

1. Create your own instance of Mastodon or any other fediverse server
2. Write your own 'rules'

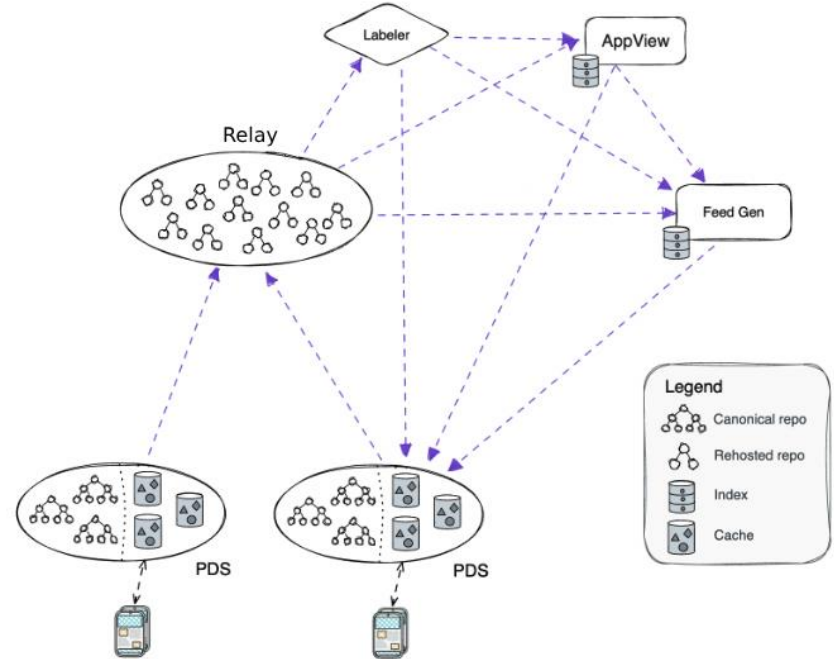
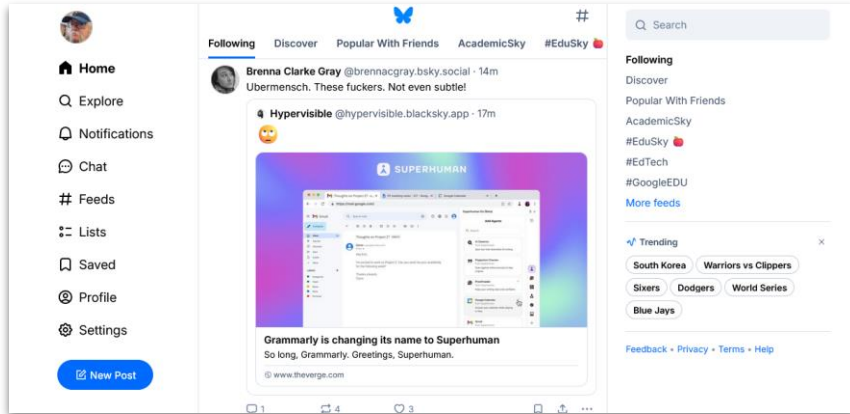

- **Feeds** – User-created timelines of posts populated by options drawn from Bluesky usually on a specific topic
- **Starter Packs** – Up to 150 collected accounts organized/curated by a user, ideally on a unifying theme,
- **Lists** – Collections of accounts created by a user.

Introducing OpenLearn Commons: A Federated Alternative to the LMS

OpenLearn Commons is not a single platform but an assemblage of purpose-built services, each part of the Fediverse or otherwise open and extensible:

- **Mastodon** for announcements and course discussion
- **WriteFreely** for student journals and reflective writing
- **Lemmy** for topic-based conversation and community Q&A
- **PeerTube** for lectures and student video projects
- **Nextcloud** for file sharing and collaborative editing
- **Grav CMS** for publishing modular course content in Markdown
- **Keycloak** for single sign-on and identity management

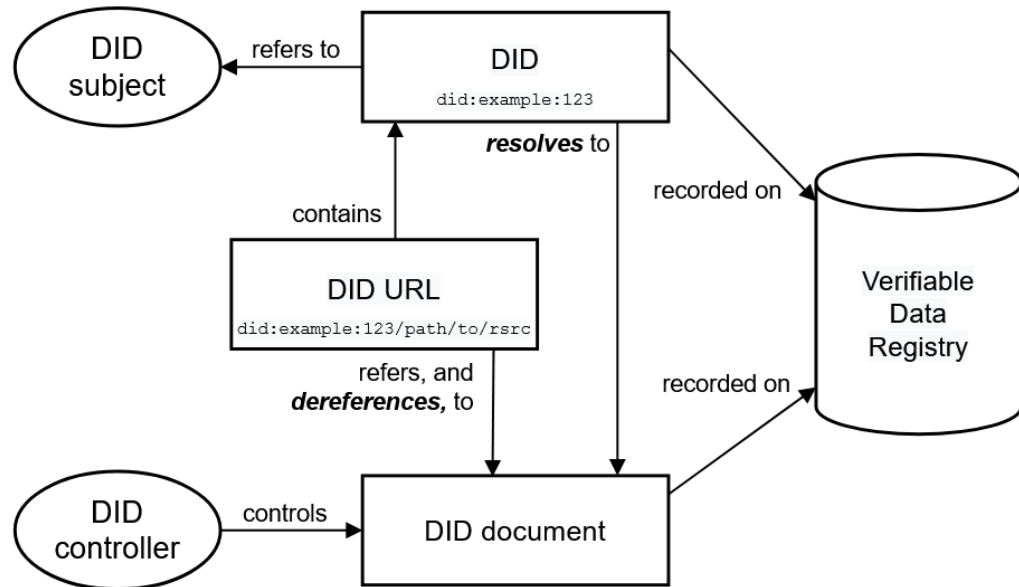


Figure 2 Overview of DID architecture and the relationship of the basic components. See also: [narrative description](#).

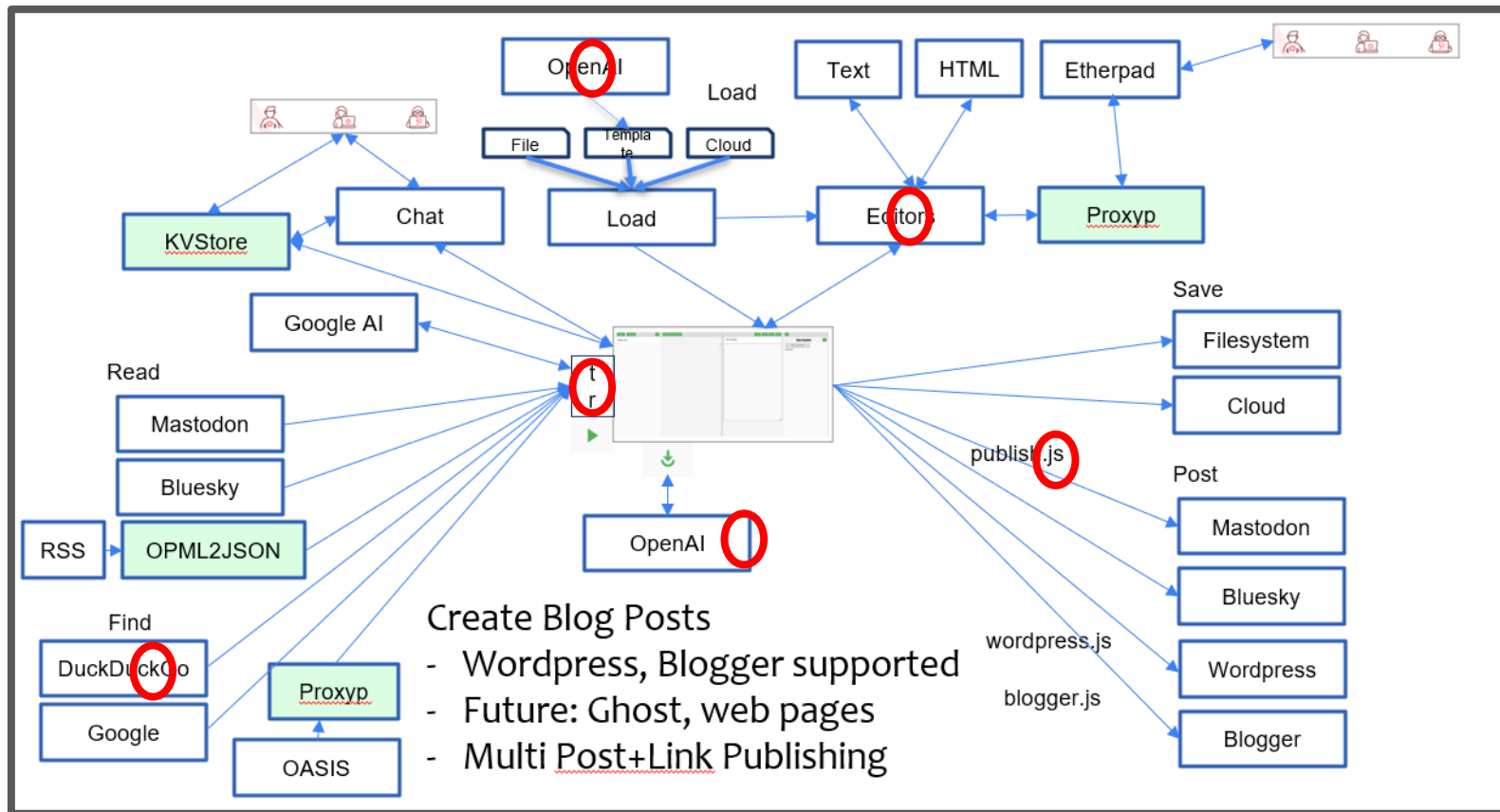
